

### **Instruction for Contributors**

1. Journal of Institute of Forestry, Tribhuvan University, Nepal, publishes three types of articles: research reviews, research papers, and research notes. All types of articles will be reviewed by at least one reviewer. Research reviews providing a synthesis of previously published literature and should not exceed 7,000 words, research papers should not exceed 6,000 words and research notes should not exceed 2,500 words excluding abstract, keywords, references, captions, tables, figures, and/or supplementary materials. Longer articles will be considered for exceptional cases upon approval of the Editor in Chief.
2. Manuscripts must be accompanied by a letter providing the name, affiliation, and contact information for all authors. The cover letter must also include a statement that the manuscript has not been published /submitted for publication elsewhere.
3. The name and address of the corresponding author must be indicated in the manuscript, if there is more than one author.
4. Manuscript should be typed with double-spaces and margins of at least one inch on all sides.
5. Articles should include an abstract of not more than 200 words.
6. All manuscripts should be submitted electronically in Microsoft Word format at to [faculty@iofpc.edu.np](mailto:faculty@iofpc.edu.np) or [jha.pabitra@gmail.com](mailto:jha.pabitra@gmail.com).
7. Articles should be written in “FOREST SCIENCE” (see <http://www.forest-science.org/>) format.
8. Tables and figures should be kept to a minimum and should not be embedded in the text, but should be submitted as separate files. A short descriptive title should appear above each table and be numbered. Similarly, a short descriptive title should appear below each figure and be numbered.
9. Opinions expressed in the articles are those of the authors and do not necessarily reflect the opinions of the editors or the editorial board. Individual readers and non-profit libraries are permitted to copy articles for teaching and research purposes provided appropriate acknowledgement is made to the journal and the author(s).
